Subject: Discontinuation of Basaglar Exception

Dear Provider:

Effective March 23, 2022, AmeriHealth Caritas District of Columbia (DC) will no longer permit Basaglar to pay at point of sale for enrollees. Enrollees who have been receiving Basaglar due to a short-term supply issue with insulin glargine-yfgn will be required to switch back to one of our covered products now that the supply issues are resolved.

Please note that the current preferred long-acting insulins covered for AmeriHealth Caritas DC enrollees include the following products:

- <u>Semglee (insulin glargine)</u>
 - Semglee (insulin glargine) will pay at point of sale with a quantity limit of 30 milliliters per 30 days and is in the process of being phased out by the manufacturer.

Insulin glargine-yfgn

- Insulin glargine-yfgn will pay at point of sale with a quantity limit of 30 milliliters per 30 days.
- It is considered interchangeable by the FDA, allowing substitution at pharmacies for the reference product, Lantus.
