Program-participating specialty providers with scores lower than two and a half are listed in the Referral Guide in alphabetical order but do not have a score indicated.

Specialist providers who do not meet the minimum number of attributed episodes for the episode category associated with their specialty, or who are part of a practice that has opted out of the program, are not listed in the AmeriHealth Caritas COMPASS Referral Guide. Hospital Referral Region Explanation

In-network specialty providers are scored based on their ranked performance against peers meeting the episode category criteria within a hospital referral region (HRR). HRRs are geographic delineations that use zip code area groupings to define unique healthcare market regions.

Episode Categories Explanation

The episode categories used in the AmeriHealth Caritas COMPASS program have condition-specific definitions that group the entire range of care used to treat a clinical condition for a specific time period across the continuum of care. The episode categories are defined by PROMETHEUS Analytics® and are used across the health care sector. Episode category descriptions are included in the AmeriHealth Caritas COMPASS Program Guide.
