AmeriHealth Caritas District of Columbia (DC) is updating its value-based compensation program for providers who provide health services to AmeriHealth Caritas DC enrollees. Please see the updates for the 2023 program listed below.

Quality Enhancement Program for Primary Care Providers (PCP)

PCP's will begin seeing data on the three measures listed below in the AmeriHealth Caritas (3M) dashboard:

- Depression Remission or Response for Adolescents and Adults (DRR)
- Depression Screening and Follow-Up for Adolescents and Adults (DSF)
- Utilization of the PHQ-9 to Monitor Depression Symptoms for Adolescents and Adults (DMS)

The Perinatal Quality Enhancement Program

The Quality Performance Incentive pool will be distributed across the quality performance measures as follows:

- Timeliness of prenatal care 35%
- Postpartum care 35%
- Dental screening 15%
- STI testing 15%
 - o Chlamydia screening
 - o HIV screening

Obstetrics (OB) providers will begin receiving data in the OB Quality Enhancement Program (QEP) scorecards on their rate for, "Cesarean Rate for Low-Risk First Birth Women."

Behavioral Health Provider Quality Enhancement Program

QEP components will be measured for behavioral health providers with panels averaging 50 or more enrollees. The average of 50 is based on a defined average enrollment period for the measurement year. Practices that provide behavioral health services to fewer than 50 enrollees per quarter are not eligible for participation in the QEP.

2023 payments for the BHQEP will follow the schedule listed below:

Schedule Membership Period	Payment Date
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Cycle 1	1/1/2023 - 6/30/2023	December 2023
Cycle 2	7/1/2023 - 12/31/2023	June 2024
