Subject:	Additional EOB Codes will appear on your Remittance Advices starting August 1, 2020

Summary: Effective August 1, 2020, AmeriHealth Caritas District of Columbia (DC) is transitioning to a new claim editing vendor. Therefore, you may begin to see additional Explanation of Benefits (EOB) explanation codes on zero paid lines. Read on to learn more about this transition and the new codes you may see.

Background:

Currently, edits are applied *after* a payment is calculated. The new process, effective August 1, 2020, will apply coding and billing edits *before* pricing. This change necessitated the creation of a new set of EOB codes; all of the new EOB codes are recognizable by starting with a lower case alpha value. Update:

Effective August 1, 2020, you may begin to see remittance advices with the "new" EOB codes, starting with lower case alpha values, instead of the "H" and "N" codes you currently receive.
