**Subject:** **Notice to enrollees under age 21 of scheduled, due, and overdue services.**

**Summary:** Primary dental providers (PDPs) are required to remind enrollees on their PDP panel of the importance of an annual dental visit.

### **Impact**

As stated in the dental provider supplement, dental providers serving as PDPs for enrollees under age 21 must notify each enrollee of scheduled, due, and overdue services according to their normal operating procedures. This requirement is derived directly from AmeriHealth Caritas District of Columbia's managed care contract with the Department of Health Care Finance.
